The BSc (Hons) in Finance and Accounting offered by UGM Manchester provides excellent exposure to the principles and practices of accounting and finance. Alongside this key benefit, you will develop specialist accounting knowledge in areas such as financial auditing, reporting and taxation, supported by expert teaching and a broader understanding of business economics, planning, strategy and performance.
